## Town Manager's Report

It's amazing that we are already starting the second month of 2012. I hope everyone is having a great start so far and keeping up with their New Year's resolutions! February is one of our busiest months. With more residents around, we have more eyes to notice things. Please let the office know of anything you see that needs attention. Our staff wants to do everything we can to keep Village Walk looking its best.

Thank you to those 40-plus residents who recently stepped up this past month and got their necessary cleaning done as required. However we still have more homes that need cleaning attention. If your home falls in this group, please do right by your neighbors and the Association and get the necessary cleaning done as required.

**Good News!** As reported to us by the County, the newly approved FEMA flood maps put all of Village Walk in an X zone. This means you will not be required to buy flood insurance for your home. The County should be releasing the flood map to the public sometime this month.

There are sod problems throughout certain parts of the community. We are in daily communication with our landscape company to make sure all necessary steps are being taken to remedy the problems and create an environment where the sod will flourish. However, there are some more areas that will need to be replaced. We are planning to start our next sod replacement project sometime in late March or as the weather permits. Let us know if you think your sod needs attention so we can check it out and add to our list if necessary.

For several months we have posted notices informing each resident that they need to turn in an authorization form to give Village Walk permission to include them in the upcoming Village Walk Phone Directory. Only 500 residents so far have turned in their forms. That leaves 350 residents out of the directory. Remember, the Florida Statutes changed and now require your written permission before we can list your information in the phone directory. Your listing in last year's directory does not qualify as permission to include you in the upcoming directory. Please call or stop by the Village Walk office for an authorization form. **Final dead line is Friday, February 10 before the directory goes to print.**

We notice on recent landscaping tours that some homeowners still have their holiday decorations up. Village Walk supports decorations during the holidays but requires them removed when the holiday is over. Deadline for removal was January 10<sup>th</sup>. Please remove your decorations if you have not done so already.

### **Reminders:**

The Annual meeting is scheduled for March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at Temple Shalom. Do you have a resident in mind that you think goes out of his or her way to help the association and should be nominated for the "Above and Beyond" award? Deadline for all nominations is February 28th. All entries are to be turned in at the Town Hall office.

**Feb 2** **The Paris Wife** by Paula McLain

A story of ambition and betrayal, **The Paris Wife** captures a remarkable period of time and a love affair between two unforgettable people: Ernest Hemingway and his wife Hadley.

**Mar 1** **Postmistress** by Sarah Blake

Iris James is the postmistress and spinster of Franklin, Massachusetts, a small town on Cape Cod. Iris knows a lot more about the townspeople that she will ever say. She firmly believes that her job is to deliver and keep people's secrets, to pass along the news of love and sorrow that letters carry. Yet one day Iris does the unthinkable: she slips a letter into her pocket. And then she does something even worse --- she reads the letter, and then doesn't deliver it.

Meanwhile, seemingly fearless American radio gal Frankie Bard is working with Edward R. Murrow, reporting from the Blitz in London. Frankie's radio dispatches crinkle across the Atlantic, imploring listeners to pay attention to what is going on as the Nazis bomb London nightly. Then, in the last, desperate days of the summer of 1941, Frankie rides the trains out of Germany and reports what is happening. But while most of the townspeople of Franklin are convinced the war "overseas" can't touch them, Iris knows better.

Alternating between an America on the eve of entering into World War II, still safe and snug in its inability to grasp the danger at hand, and a Europe being torn apart by war, the two stories collide in a letter, bringing the war finally home to Franklin.

**The Postmistress** is a tale of unforgettable women, of lost innocence, of what happens to love when those we cherish leave us. It examines how we tell each other stories --- how we bear the fact that that war is going on at the same time as ordinary lives continue. Filled with stunning parallels to our lives today, it is a remarkable novel.
